There is an increase in human trafficking related to gang activity and narcotics investigations. Frequently Human trafficking cases present to local law enforcement as something else – teenage runaways, simple assault, domestic violence, rape, or other state crimes. Knowing the signs and indicators could lead from a simple assault to identifying a human trafficking victim and helping to prosecute a pimp who is prostituting teenagers.

This training will focus on both the international and domestic sides of human trafficking in order to show that this crime is victimizing both U.S. citizens and foreign nationals. This training could be helpful for all patrolmen and detectives who are routinely dealing with calls involving simple or aggravated assaults, prostitution, domestic violence, sexual assaults, narcotics violations, gang activity or any crimes involving teenagers.
